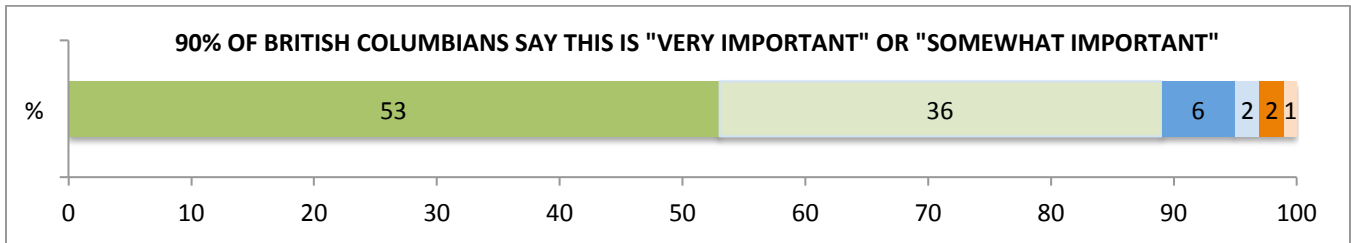
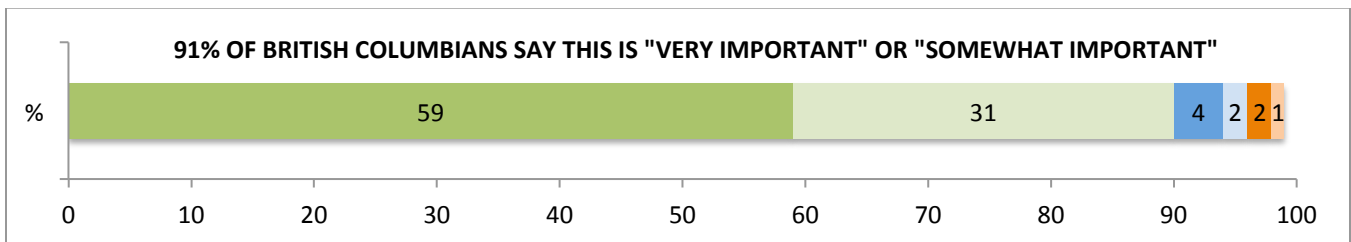


TELEPHONE POLLING RESULTS¹ - LIQUIFIED NATURAL GAS CARBON LEADERSHIP

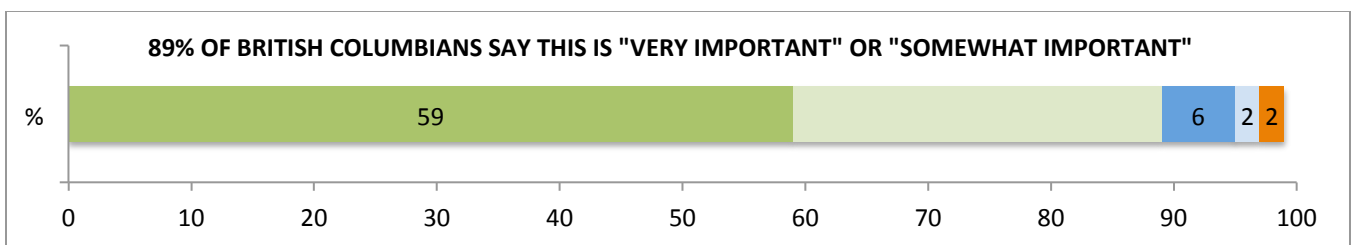
1. The Government of British Columbia has committed that the province will have the cleanest liquefied natural gas, or LNG, in the world. How important is it to you that BC's LNG be the cleanest in the world?



2. LNG plants need huge amounts of energy to compress natural gas into a liquid form so it can be transported. There are two ways to power an LNG plant. Plants can either run on pure natural gas, a fossil fuel, or a combination of renewable energy and natural gas. How important is it for you that the proposed plants maximize their use of renewable energy?



3. How important is minimizing greenhouse gas emissions in the proposed LNG industry if this means less LNG is developed?

¹ Clean Energy Canada at Tides Canada commissioned NRG Research Group to conduct a poll regarding British Columbians' perspectives on LNG. Six hundred calls were made in British Columbia with 300 in Greater Vancouver/Lower Mainland and 300 in other areas of the Province. The results were weighted to reflect the actual proportion of the population in each of the regions by age and gender. The interviews were completed by telephone between October 4th and October 6th, 2013. A survey of 600 respondents is representative of the population from which it is drawn within +/- 4.1%, 19 times out of 20.
